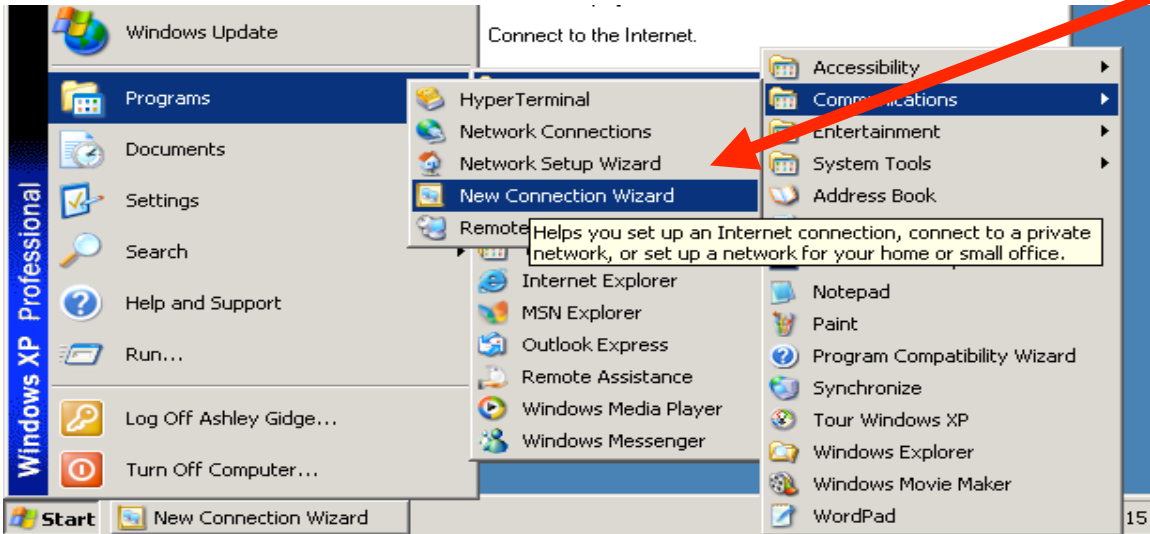
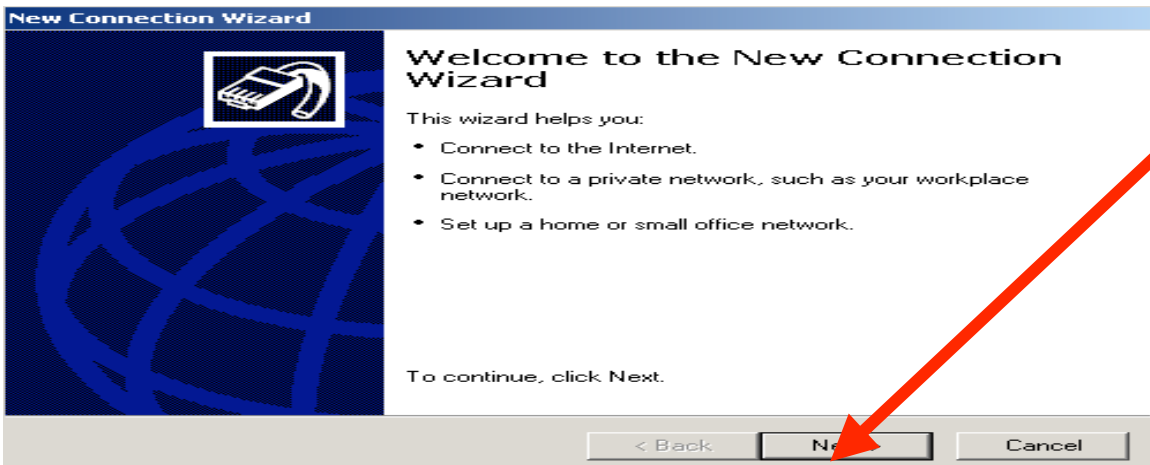


Configure Dial Up Networking for Windows XP

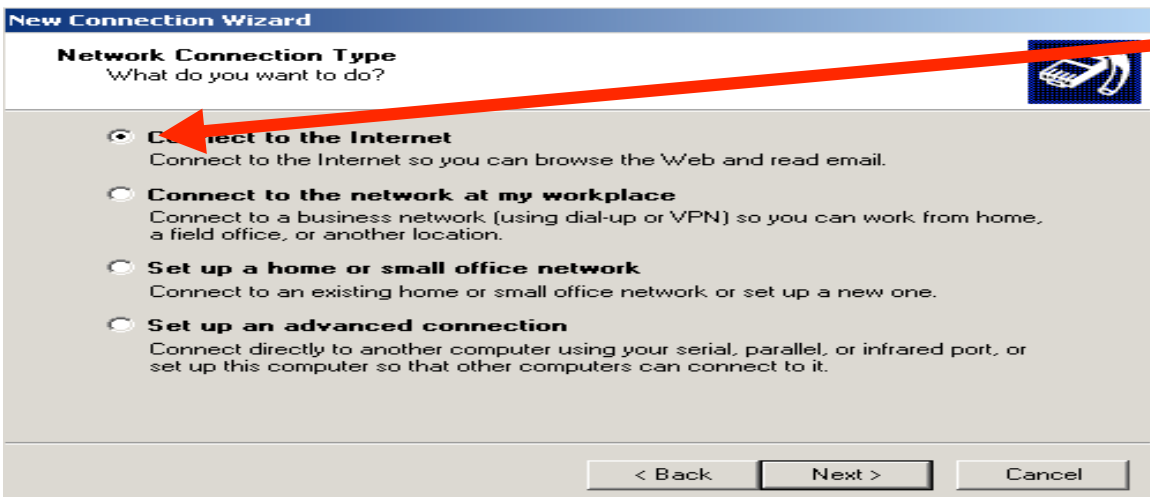
1. Click **Start, Programs, Accessories, Communications, and New Connection Wizard**



2. The first window explains what the wizard will help you configure. Click the **Next** button



3. Click the button next to **Connect to the Internet**. Click the **Next** button



4. Select Set up my connection manually. Click the Next button

New Connection Wizard

Getting Ready

For a dial-up connection, you will need your account name, password, and a phone number for your ISP. For a broadband account, you won't need a phone number.

5. Select Connect using a dial-up modem. Click the Next button

Internet Connection
How do you want to connect to the Internet?

- Connect using a dial-up modem**
This type of connection uses a modem and a regular or ISDN phone line.
- Connect using a broadband connection that requires a user name and password
This is a high-speed connection using either a DSL or cable modem. Your ISP may refer to this type of connection as PPPoE.
- Connect using a broadband connection that is always on
This is a high-speed connection using either a cable modem, DSL or LAN connection. It is always active, and doesn't require you to sign in.

6. Type the name of your Internet Service Provider. Click the Next button

8. Type your Username, Password, and enter your Password again for confirmation. Uncheck the box next to Turn on Internet Connection Firewall for this connection. Click the Next button

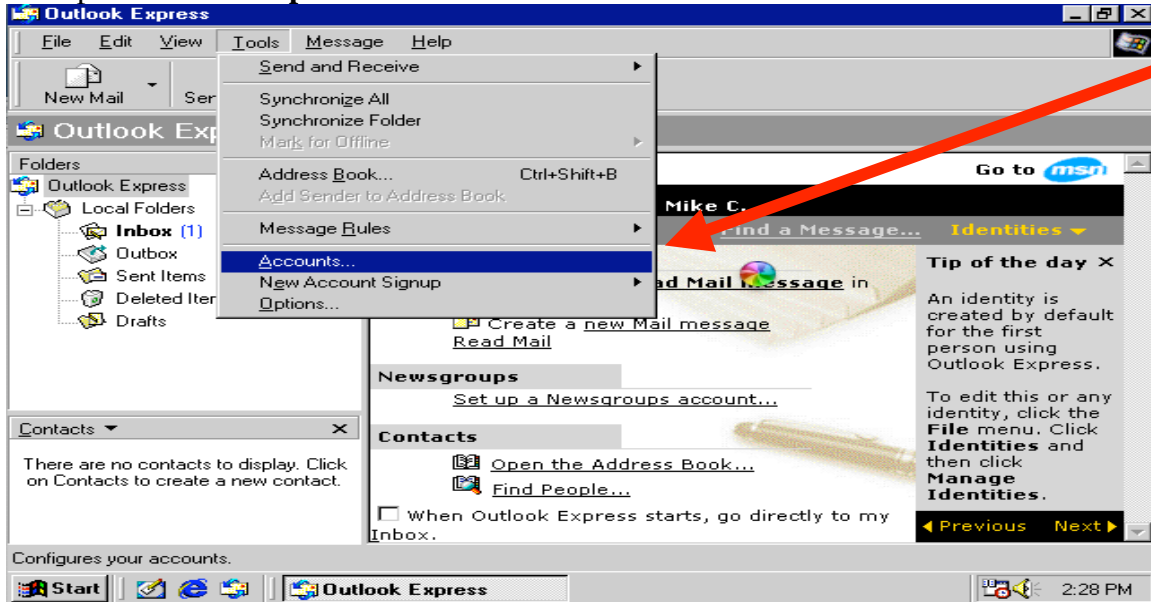

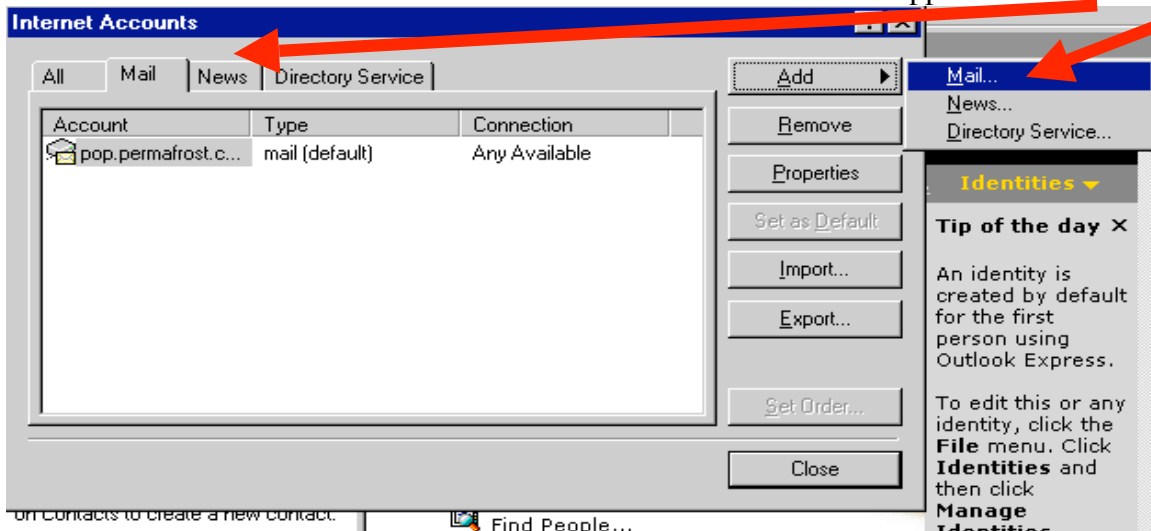

Configuring your Internet Mail account

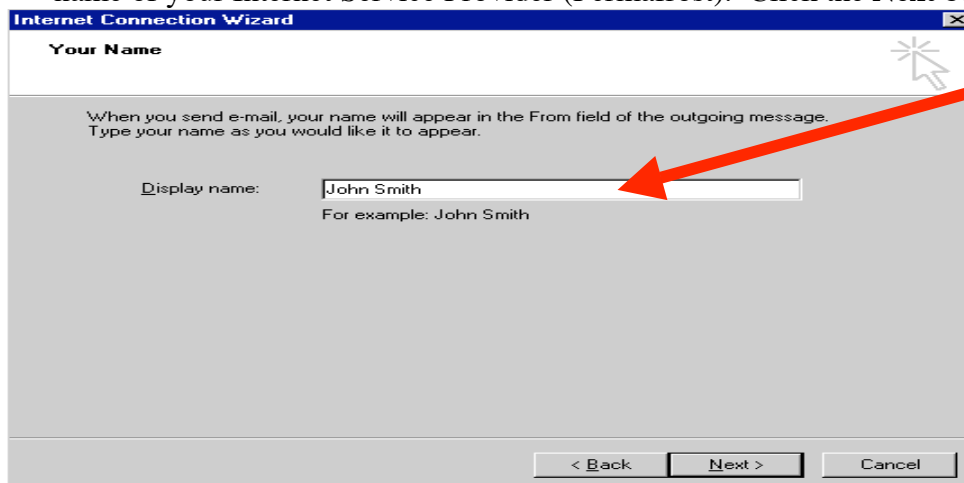
1. Open Outlook Express and click the Tools Menu and choose Accounts.



2. When the Internet Accounts window appears, select the Mail tab towards the top.
3. Click on the Add button and choose Mail from the submenu that appears.



4. The first step is to type your Display Name. A display name can be your name or the name of your Internet Service Provider (Permafrost). Click the Next button.



5. The next step is to enter your **Email Address**. New North Networks will provide this to you. Type in your email address.

6. In the next window, make sure that **POP3** is selected in the drop down list of Incoming mail servers, and type in the name of your **Incoming** and **Outgoing** mail servers in the appropriate area of the window. Click the **Next** button

E-mail Server Names

7. For the last step, you will be asked to enter the **Username** and **Password** for your email account. Username will be the name of your email address (before @permafrost.com) and whatever password you chose for your account. Click the **Next** button
